INFORMATION ABOUT OUR VINEYARDS

Sabina Vineyards produces two Cabernet Sauvignons from two different sub-appellations in the Napa Valley. The Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is grown in vineyards surrounding the Sabina Winery located in Appellation St. Helena, and the Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from two distinct vineyards located in the Oakville American Viticultural Area.

Vineyards In St. Helena

The sloping bench where Sabina Vineyards and Winery is situated along the foothills of the Mayacamas Range in the western part of St. Helena has become famous for the cultivation of Cabernet Sauvignon. Characteristics of this sub-appellation of Appellation St. Helena are red volcanic soils with high iron content, a microclimate that funnels moisture from the Pacific Ocean and nearby bays into the area causing wide diurnal temperature swings, and the farming of premiere Bordeaux red grape varieties on sloping hillsides. Neighbors include such well-established winegrowers as Grace Family Vineyard, Vineyard 29 and their Aida Vineyard, Colgin's Tychson Hill, and Stony Hill Vineyard. The wines produced from grapes grown in this area are classic, densely textured and elegant with power and finesse that are quite long-lived.

Vineyards In Oakville

Grapes for Sabina Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon from the Oakville appellation are sourced from two small, vineyard sites in this world-renowned growing region. One vineyard is planted on an extremely rocky mountain slope, while the other is from a 25-year old valley floor vineyard. These two vineyards give us the raw materials to create a wine with mouth filling texture and structure with great longevity. The Cabernet Sauvignon from Oakville makes extremely complex wine with the signature of luscious black cherry and black currant aromas and flavors. The Oakville American Viticultural Area is distinguished by its unique terroir that is conducive to growing classic, powerful Cabernet Sauvignon. Some of the most preeminent producers of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon have their vineyards in Oakville. Mountain neighbors include Screaming Eagle and Dalla Valle Vineyards.
